

Oak Hub List – Fall 2023

General Guidelines

- Gather acorns from Oregon White Oak after the second major drop of them from the trees, typically in early-mid September. The first drop is typically not viable.
- Gather from the drip line of the tree canopy inward. This can help assure that animals haven't chewed on them and taken them elsewhere.
- Make sure to give each tree you collect from a unique ID and keep acorns from each tree separate.
- Please fill out an intake form for each drop off.
